If your student is going to absent you can email Sartori.Attendance@rentonschools.us or call the 24 hour attendance line and leave a message for the office. Please include student first and last name, teacher, grade, and reason why they are out. If your student has 3 or more unexcused absences, you will need to have a conference with the assistant principal. 7 unexcused absences in a month or 10 in a year will trigger a petition to truancy court per BECCA Law.

The Renton School District School Construction measure on the Nov. 5 ballot includes a lot of work at schools across the district. Sartori Elementary School was built just last year thanks to a similar ballot measure. Also on the ballot is the <u>construction of a new elementary school</u> in the Hazen High School area. That additional elementary school is important in helping relieve the overcrowding at schools all around the Highlands area.

The good news is that because of the large number of businesses and families that have moved into the area, many more businesses and property owners combine to pay for this work; that means Renton School District will be able to do all of the work while keeping tax rates for property owners flat and not raise tax rates. School districts in Washington State do not receive any state or federal funding to do these kinds of large-scale construction projects to improve our school and to build much-needed new schools. That work can only be done if voters approve School Construction measures on the election ballot. 
